## Project Title and Location:

Fuel Storage Building, W. G. Huxtable Pumping Station, Marianna, AR

## Scope of Construction Work:

Dine' was awarded the contract to design and build a pre-engineered metal building for storage of fuel and lubricants for the W.G. Huxtable Pumping Station in Arianna, Arkansas. Working with the local Memphis District, US Army Corps of Engineers, the facility was designed to provide adequate space for storage of products, as well as, provide containment should any product leak from its container.

The site, located beside the St. Frances River, presented geotechnical challenges that had to be addressed during the project design and construction. Dine' and its design team dealt with these challenges efficiently, completing the project ahead of schedule.

The fuel storage building was a 3200 square foot facility. The project included a pre-engineered metal building with a standing seam roof for both indoor and outdoor storage, overhead doors, site work, site utilities and fencing.
