Dine' Construction Project Receives Top Marks From United States Army Corps of Engineers

Three Building Projects Totaling 11,200 Square Feet Completed in Four Months

Savannah, GA –The Dine' Construction, LLC (www.dineconstruction.com) has received top ranking from the United States Army Corps of Engineers for a recently completed project at Ft. Gordon in Savannah, Georgia. Completing the project for the CECOMS staff for three buildings in a record four months, Dine' received top marks for Quality Control, Timely Performance, Effectiveness of Management, Compliance with Labor Laws, and Compliance with Safety Standards.

Dine' was awarded the contract to design and build a three building modular training facility composed of 5800 square feet of administrative and laboratory space and 5400 square feet of classroom space. During the design phase of the project, Dine' worked closely with the CECOMS staff and the United States Army Corps of Engineers to ensure that the facility met the needs of the training staff and stayed within budget.

The CECOMS training schedule dictated that the project be complete and ready for use within four months of the notice to proceed. Through careful scheduling and extended work hours, Dine' and its suppliers and subcontractor were able to turn the facility over to the user within 120 days of the award.

The facility includes seven classrooms with individual power and data connections equipped for audio/visual presentations. An 1800 square foot covered Humvee doc serves as an outdoor classroom for satellite communication instruction. The Administrative Building includes both private and open cubicle offices, all with voice and data connections. The project included over 4000 feet of fiber optic cable installation, CATV systems, fire alarm and sprinkler systems, lightning protection, site utilities, fencing, landscaping, and a paved parking lot.
